- ▶ 98% employment rate with a high percentage of trainees employed in partner schools



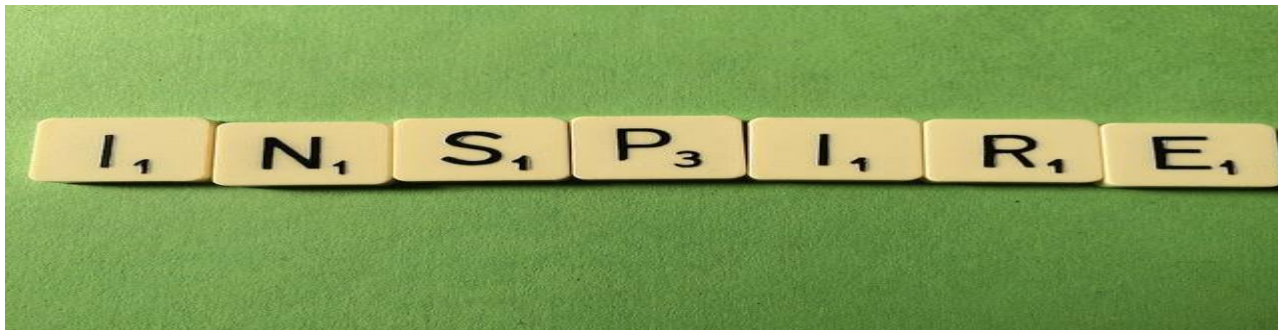
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# Entry Requirements

- ▶ Post Graduate entry only
- ▶ \*Degree at 2:2 or above
- ▶ GCSE Maths and English at Grade C/4 or above
- ▶ GCSE Science at Grade C/4 or above required for Primary PGCE course
- ▶ Relevant school experience is recommended – but **not** essential. WMC can provide support in arranging this



# Finance

- ▶ £9,250 course fees for PGCE PE, Dance and Primary courses
- ▶ £4,625 for PE with EBacc until **March 2020**
- ▶ **No** bursaries currently available for PGCE trainees
- ▶ Bursaries available for shortage secondary subjects – maths, physics, chemistry, geography, computing, classics, biology and languages – **School Direct (Training)**
- ▶ **School Direct (Salaried)** trainees paid at point 1 of the unqualified teacher scale – currently £17, 682. **No** cost for training but **no** access to Student Finance

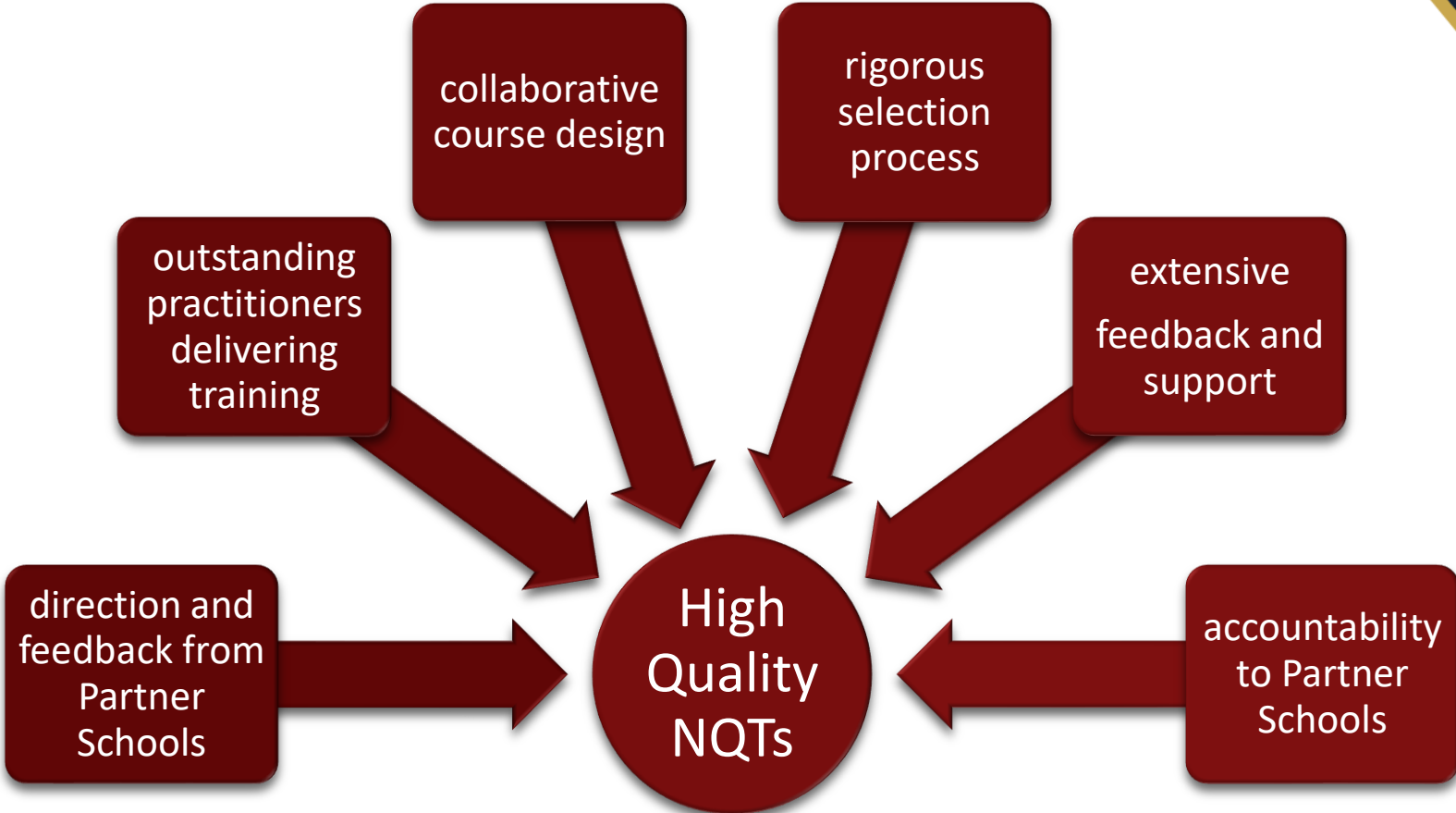
